When you interact with our advertising and applications on third-party websites and services, if those applications or advertising include links to this policy.

It does not apply to information collected by:

Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We collect several types of information from and about users of our Website, including information:

Information You Provide to Us

The information we collect on or through our Website may include:

Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us.

Details of transactions you carry out through our Website and of the fulfillment of your orders. You may be required to provide financial information before placing an order through our Website.

Your search queries on the Website.

From time to time, we collect and process sensitive personal information which may include racial or ethnic origin, genetic data, biometric data, and data concerning health. Other than a few necessary exceptions, you are never required to provide this information, but may consent to our processing it. For example, you may provide information about your personal fitness (exercise regimen, workout routines, vital sign numbers, etc.) on your personal bio page to share that information with other members of the HYROX community. Whenever the processing of this data is based on consent, you are free to withdraw that consent at any time by removing such information or asking us to remove it for you.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies
